



## To install the Ethernet cable glands


1. Unscrew the sealing nut from the panel connector and remove the seal and claw.

Panel Connector


Seal and Claw



- 2. Thread the RJ-45 plug through the sealing nut then the panel connector.
- 3. Wrap the seal and claw around the cable between the sealing nut and panel connector.



- 4. Insert the RJ-45 plug into the PoE port on the unit and screw the panel connector onto the threaded coupling at the port.
- 5. Slide the seal and claw along the cable into panel connector.



6. Thread the coupling ring onto the panel connector and tighten it until the seal and claw are compressed, making a watertight seal on the cable.



## To install the Power cable gland

1. Disassemble the power cable gland by unscrewing the sealing nut, removing the seal and claw, then unscrewing the sealing body from the housing.

2. Thread the power cable through the sealing nut, seal and claw, sealing body, gasket, and lock nut, then solder the power cable to the housing.



3. Slide the seal and claw into one end of the sealing body and the gasket into the other, then slide the lock nut over the housing, and the o-ring onto it.



 Screw the sealing body onto the housing then screw the sealing nut onto the sealing body using 8-10 Kgf·cm (0.78 to 0.98 Nm) of torque.



5. Plug the cable into the power port on the device then tightly screw the lock nut onto the threaded coupling to ensure a proper seal.

## Installation


**IMPORTANT NOTE:** The device must be professionally installed.


This unit is designed for outdoor use and may be mounted on a wall or attached to a pole. Waterproof connectors are supplied to ensure watertight seals when connecting the Ethernet and power cables to the device.


## To attach the mounting bracket


Fasten the wall-mount base securely to the back of the unit using the four provided M6x12 mounting screws.

The mounting bracket can be fastened vertically or horizontally.











## To mount the device on a wall

- 1. Use the mounting bracket to mark the location of the mounting holes on a flat wall surface.
- 2. Drill the mounting holes in the marked locations.
- 3. Insert the four provided anchors into the drilled holes.
- 4. Attach the unit to the wall using the provided wood screws.
- 5. Tighten the screws and ensure that that device is firmly in place.



## To mount the device unit on a pole

- 1. Loop the provided pole mounting straps through the slots on the mounting bracket and then around the pole.
- 2. Tighten the strap with an appropriate screwdriver and ensure that the device is firmly in place.




The device can be mounted to poles that are horizontal or vertical, with the mounting bracket fastened vertically or horizontally.

## Grounding

Adequate grounding must be provided to the device. A grounding kit, including a grounding wire and two M4 screws with washers, is provided. Consult a certified electrician to ensure that all grounding and cabling is installed in compliance with the local electrical code.


## To connect the grounding cable

- 1. Locate the ground connection on the bottom of the device.
- 2. Align one end of the green grounding wire over the ground connection, then secure the wire with one of the provided M4 screws washers.



3. Connect the other end of the grounding wire to an appropriate grounding location, such as a grounded electrical system or grounding rod.

In addition to the grounding terminal of the plug, on the back panel, three is another, separate terminal for earthing.

Ce produit possède une borne de mise à la terre qui est prévu à l'arrière du produit, à ceci s'ajoute la mise à la terre de la prise.

This product has a separate protective earthing terminal provided on the back of the product in addition to the grounding terminal of the attachment plug. This separate protective earthing terminal must be permanently connected to earth with a green with yellow stripe conductor minimum size # 14 AWG and the connection is to be installed by a qualified service personnel.
